

Update: City of Toronto's Third Party Sign Tax By-law upheld by Ontario Superior Court

In a Decision dated March 3, 2011 on an application to quash the effect of a municipal Bylaw to tax third party signage, the Ontario Superior Court of Justice upheld the ability of the City of Toronto to impose a tax on the owners of third party signs through the City's Third Party Sign Tax Bylaw No. 197-2010 (Municipal Code Chapter 771), while at the same time grandfathering existing signage as at 6 April 2010.
