Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act -PIPEDA

Private Sector Laws PIPEDA

Does not apply within a province if it has "substantially similar legislation"

- Alberta, British Columbia, and Quebec all passed substantially similar legislation
- Ontario has too but only with respect to personal health info^{Blaney} McMurtr

- Personal Health Information Protection Act, 2004 - PHIPA
- Only personal health information that is collected, used, or disclosed by health information custodians
- Custodians provide health care services directly to an individual

Canada's Anti-Spam Legislation -CASL

In force since July 1, 2014

 Applies to all forms of electronic communication (including emails, texts) that promote or encourage commercial activity



Three main criteria:1. Consent2. Identity of sender3. Unsubscribe



Enforcement

- Administrative penalty \$1 million per violation (individual) and \$10 million per violation (any other "person")
- Private right of action damages up to \$200 per violation up to \$1 million per day







What if I don't comply?

Investigations by the Privacy Commissioner Potential lawsuits Embarrassment / loss of reputation



Privacy Breaches

- Unauthorized access to, or collection, use, or disclosure of, personal information
- Could occur when personal information is stolen, lost or mistakenly disclosed
- Could result from internal or external forces



Breach Response

1. Containment and preliminary assessment

Evaluate the risks
 Notify affected individuals
 Prevention
